STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance, Department of Commerce and Economic Development ("the division"), Horace Mann Insurance Co. ("Horace Mann"), and Teachers Insurance Co. ("Teachers") stipulate and agree to the following in resolution of this matter.

I. FACTS

- 1. Horace Mann and Teachers are both members of The Horace Mann Companies corporate family, and are both admitted insurers in the State of Alaska with each holding a certificate of authority issued by the division.
- 2. Both Horace Mann and Teachers are obligated to comply with AS 21.36.220, the statute providing requirements which an insurer must follow in communicating to an insured notice of cancellation of an insurance policy.
- 3. On March 14, 1995, a consumer complaint was brought to the attention of the division by Laverne Barnica, an insured under a personal automobile insurance policy issued by Teachers.

A subsequent investigation by the division revealed that Horace Mann and Teachers had violated provisions of AS 21.36.220 on numerous occasions involving many insureds.

- 4. Horace Mann and Teachers provided documentation to the division during the course of the investigation establishing over 50 instances during the period from January 1, 1994 until May 2, 1995, in which an Alaska insured was given inadequate notice of cancellation.
- 5. Horace Mann, Teachers and the division desire to resolve all existing violations of AS 21.36.220 through this Stipulated Agreement and Order.

II. STIPULATION

- 6. Horace Mann and Teachers each admit to a "practice" in violation of AS 21.36.220. This admission applies to all existing violations of the statute by both insurers as of the date this document is signed by the division's attorney.
- 7. Horace Mann and Teachers agree to jointly pay a fine for the above "practice," pursuant to AS 21.36.320, in the total amount of \$25,000, with \$10,000 suspended.
- 8. Horace Mann and Teachers agree to not intentionally or knowingly violate Alaska's insurance code (AS 21).
- 9. If Horace Mann or Teachers, or their agents and employees, are found to have intentionally or knowingly violated AS 21 during a three year period commencing with the date this Stipulated Agreement and Order is approved by the director, the
