STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance, Department of Commerce and Economic Development (division) and Acordia Northwest, Inc., dba Acordia/Pettit-Morry Co. (Acordia), the firm under which April Chanes holds Alaska insurance license #6586, stipulate and agree that the violations of the insurance code arising out of the failure to timely renew Ms. Chanes' license and the resulting unlicensed activity are resolved as follows:

1. Acordia admits that in 1992 Ms. Chanes forwarded her license renewal form to Acordia's licensing coordinator for processing in the customary manner of Acordia. Ms. Chanes subsequently received a notice of impending cancellation from the division, which she also turned over to the licensing coordinator. Acordia admits that Ms. Chanes' individual in a firm

insurance license was not properly renewed by Acordia and fell into lapse status on November 10, 1992 and remained lapsed until Acordia discovered its error on or about June 4, 1996. During that period of time, under Acordia's supervision, Ms. Chanes transacted the business of insurance, in violation of AS 21.27.380(b) and, due to the unlicensed activity, Acordia was in violation of AS 21.27.140. 2. Under AS 21.27.420(c), the division agrees to reinstate Ms. Chanes' insurance license subject to the condition that Acordia pay a civil

- penalty of \$500 with \$250 suspended. The unsuspended portion of the penalty is payable no later than 30 days from the date this agreement and order is signed by the director.
- 3. In the event Acordia violates the insurance code or applicable regulations during the next two years (in particular, failure to renew the license of any of its employees timely), the suspended portion of the fine referenced in paragraph 2 will be reinstated. Acordia also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
- 4. By signing this agreement, Acordia understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or non-renew Alaska insurance firm license #7947.
