# STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance, (division) and Heffernan-Petersen Insurance Brokers (Heffernan), the licensee in this case, stipulate and agree that the unlicensed activity that occurred before Heffernan applied for and the division issued license #18684 to it and license #5022 to Edward J. Dantzig as its Principal/Compliance Officer is resolved as follows:

1. Heffernan brokers and administers a national program for the Presbyterian Church. Heffernan admits that, although the firm did not initially solicit the insurance business or advertise its insurance products in Alaska, upon its request, Heffernan did prepare a proposal for the Presbytery of the Yukon in Anchorage, a member of the Synod of the Pacific. The Presbytery then sent premium money to the Synod of the Pacific, which in turn arranged for coverage under its master policy through Heffernan. While in Alaska, the Presbytery accepted Heffernan's proposal and coverage was bound, effective April 1, 1998 to February 1, 1999.

- 3. Heffernan admits that the policy for the Presbytery was renewed on February 1, 1999 for a year. This renewal occurred before Heffernan was issued its Alaska licenses on March 17, 1999, which is also a violation of AS 21.27.010.
- 4. Heffernan agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440(a) of \$1,815.72, which equals the amount of commissions it earned for the unlicensed activity that occurred between April 1, 1998 and March 16, 1999, with \$900 suspended. The unsuspended portion of the penalty is due no later than six months from the date this agreement and order is signed by the director.
- 5. In the event Heffernan violates the insurance code or applicable regulations during the next two years (in particular, failure to renew the licenses timely), the suspended portion of the fine referenced in paragraph 4 will be reinstated. Heffernan also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
- 6. By signing this agreement, Heffernan understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska insurance licenses #18684 and #5022.
