STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Inter/National Rental Insurance, Inc., d/b/a USI Rental Specialty (Inter/National), and James P. Bankson, (Mr. Bankson) Compliance Officer for Inter/National, the licensees in this case, stipulate and agree that the unlicensed activity that occurred when Inter/National and Mr. Bankson were not appropriately licensed is resolved as follows:

- 1. Inter/National was first issued firm insurance producer license #8291 in 1983. Mr. Bankson was first issued license #4875 in 1992 and in 2002 he became the Compliance Officer for Inter/National.
- 2. Although Inter/National submitted its license renewal application on January 6, 2004, the firm did not respond to the division's request for information and on January 23, 2004 the firm's license lapsed. Mr. Bankson was also notified that he was not authorized to transact on be half of the firm, and on June 11, 2004 his license also lapsed.

3. In February and April of 2005, the division received application paperwork necessary to reinstate the firm and Mr. Bankson's licenses, and the division reinstated both licenses effective June 21, 2005. As required by the division, notarized statements were submitted listing whether business had been transacted while the licenses were in lapse status. The statements indicated that unlicensed activity had occurred between January 23, 2004 and May 19, 2005.

- 4. Inter/National and Mr. Bankson agree to pay a civil penalty under
 AS 21.27.440(a) in the amount of \$33,726.20, which equals the amount of commission earned
 for the unlicensed activity between January 23, 2004 and May 19, 2005, with \$20,000
 suspended. The unsuspended portion of the penalty is payable within six months from the date
 Inter/National and Mr. Bankson are notified that the director has signed the order approving this
 agreement.
- 5. In the event Inter/National or Mr. Bankson violates the insurance code or applicable regulations during the next two years, the suspended portion of the fine referenced in paragraph 4 will be reinstated. Inter/National and Mr. Bankson also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
- 6. By signing this agreement, Inter/National and Mr. Bankson understand and agree that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska insurance license #8291 and 4875.
- Inter/National and Mr. Bankson understand that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
