STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Christopher L. Heisten (Mr. Heisten), the licensee in this matter, stipulate and agree to the following:

I. BACKGROUND

- A. On or about May 27, 2008, the division issued an individual in a firm insurance producer license to Mr. Heisten, under license number 71243 based on the application that Mr. Heisten submitted to the division on or about May 16, 2008.
- B. Question 40(1) of the application asks: "Have you ever been convicted of, or are you currently charged with, committing a crime, whether or not adjudication was withheld?" To this question, Mr. Heisten answered "no."
- C. When Mr. Heisten's application was completed and his answers on the application did not indicate any reason not to issue him a license, the division issued the license.
- D. In September 2008, the division received a criminal history report that revealed misdemeanor criminal convictions in 1998 and 2002 against Mr. Heisten. In response

to the division's request, Mr. Heisten apologized for not disclosing the misdemeanors and explained that he had been answering so many questions regarding his licensing that he must have forgotten. He provided information regarding the convictions, for which he was sentenced for reckless driving, fined \$250 and had his license suspended for 30 days. In a later incident, he pled guilty to charges of furnishing alcohol to a minor and disorderly conduct, for which he was fined \$700. All requirements of his convictions have been completed.

II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

- 1. Mr. Heisten agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440(a) in the amount of \$500, with \$250 suspended. The civil penalty is payable at the time Mr. Heisten is notified that the director has signed the order approving this agreement.
- 2. In the event Mr. Heisten violates the insurance code or applicable regulations during the next two years, the suspended portion of the fine referenced in paragraph 1 will be reinstated. Mr. Heisten also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
- 3. By signing this agreement, Mr. Heisten understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the terms of this agreement may be grounds to revoke, further suspend, or non-renew Alaska insurance license number 71243.
- 4. Mr. Heisten understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
