STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Legacy Funeral Homes, Inc., d/b/a Chapel of Chimes Funeral Home, Northern Lights Mortuary, Kehl's Palmer Mortuary, Alaskan Memorial Park, Witzleben Legacy Funeral Home, and Kehl's Legacy Funeral Home, (Legacy), and Nelson M. Bruce (Mr. Bruce), Compliance Officer, the licensees in this case, stipulate and agree that the unlicensed activity that occurred during the time Legacy did not hold an active Alaska producer license is resolved as follows:

- 1. On June 30, 2008, the division sent Epic, Inc., the firm licensed under Alaska producer license #56974, a license renewal application. On October 10, 2008, the division notified Epic, Inc. that its insurance producer license had lapsed for failure to renew.
- 2. After receiving the application requirements necessary to reinstate Epic, Inc.'s license, the division reinstated its license effective November 4, 2008 with Mr. Bruce as the new compliance officer. The division inquired whether Epic, Inc. was appropriately

licensed since the firm was using names that were not licensed in this state. The firm responded that the firm had changed its name to Legacy effective April 3, 2008, and the division immediately rescinded the license renewals, effective December 8, 2008, as the entity that had been licensed no longer existed.

- After the name change and application requirements were received, the 3. division reinstated the licenses under the new name, effective January 27, 2009. As required by the division, Legacy submitted a notarized statement listing whether business had been transacted when the firm and Mr. Bruce were not appropriately licensed. The statement indicated that multiple insurance transactions occurred between September 17, 2008 and November 19, 2008. Between October 10, 2008 and November 4, 2008 when the firm was not appropriately licensed, it earned \$1,715.17 in commissions.
- Legacy and Mr. Bruce are responsible for ensuring that the firm and its 3. employees comply with Alaska's insurance statutes and regulations and are subject to penalties under AS 21.27.440 for unlicensed activity.
- 4. Legacy and Mr. Bruce agree to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 of \$1,715.17, which equals the amount of commission earned for the unlicensed activity that occurred between October 10, 2008 and November 4, 2008 with \$715.17 suspended. The unsuspended portion of the penalty is payable at the time Legacy and Mr. Bruce are notified that the director has signed the order approving this agreement.
- 5. In the event Legacy and Mr. Bruce violate the insurance code or applicable regulations during the next two years, the suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph 4 will be reinstated. The firm and Mr. Bruce also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
