Alaska National Insurance Company agrees that it will not pursue collection of premium on Taiga Woodcraft's workers compensation insurance policies 98F WW 80918 and previous for those subcontractors utilized by Taiga Woodcraft who did not maintain their own workers compensation insurance and who did not have their own employees;
