Mr. Lucero did submit a notarized statement with supporting documents relating that he was convicted of the offenses of interstate transportation of forged and falsely made securities, in violation of 18 USC 2314, and

aiding and abetting, in violation of 18 USC 2, as charged in 13 counts of an indictment filed September 7, 1977. The Judgment and Probation/Commitment Order issued December 28, 1977 in United States District Court, District of New Mexico, sentenced Mr. Lucero to five years confinement and five years probation after completion of the term of confinement. On July 3, 1981, Mr. Lucero was released from custody on parole in Seattle, Washington. On March 30, 1989, by order of the court, Mr. Lucero was discharged from probation and the proceedings of the case were terminated.

- AS 21.27.410(a)(7) provides that the director may refuse to issue a
 license if the applicant has been convicted of a felony.
- Pursuant to AS 21.27.020(a), 21.27.020(b)(6), and 21.27.410(a)(7), the application of Anthony E. Lucero for a nonresident insurance producer license is hereby denied.
