WHEREAS, the Certificate of Authority for THE INTEGRAL INSURANCE COMPANY, to transact the business of insurance in the State of Alaska was suspended effective August 31, 1992, and that suspension has been continued to the present.

WHEREAS, the 1998 Annual Statement of THE INTEGRAL INSURANCE COMPANY showed a negative surplus as regards to policyholders in the amount of \$4,475,631.

It is hereby ordered pursuant to the provision of AS 21.09.150(c) that Certificate of Authority No F-1130 issued to THE INTEGRAL INSURANCE COMPANY to transact the business of insurance in the State of Alaska shall continue to be suspended for a period of one year unless terminated sooner as permitted by statute.

During the period of suspension, THE INTEGRAL INSURANCE COMPANY shall not solicit or write any new or renewal business in Alaska, but shall file the Annual Statement, pay fees and any taxes due as provided by AS 21.09.170(b).

It is further ordered that Certificate of Authority No.

F-1130 will continue to be held in safekeeping by THE INTEGRAL

INSURANCE COMPANY until such time as this Order of Suspension
is lifted or is replaced by an Order of Revocation.
