WHEREAS, a Certificate of Authority to transact the business of insurance in the State of Alaska was issued to HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY, domiciled in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the District Court of Travis County, Texas, placed HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY under an Order of Rehabilitation, naming the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Texas as Receiver on November 6, 2003.

WHEREAS, the 2003 Third Quarter Statement, being the last statement filed, shows that HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY fails to meet the capital and surplus requirements of AS 21.09.070.

WHEREAS, HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY has failed to file the 2004 Annual Statement as required by AS 21.09.200 by the March 1, 2005 due date.

WHEREAS, HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY has failed to pay the 2005 continuation fee by June 30, 2004 as required by AS 21.09.130.

WHEREAS, the Certificate of Authority of HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY to conduct the business of insurance in the State of Alaska was suspended effective April 18, 2002 and the suspension has continued to the present.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the provision of
AS 21.09.140 (a) (2) that Certificate of Authority No. F-666 issued to
HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY to transact the business of insurance
in the State of Alaska shall be suspended until such time as the insurer has
returned to full compliance with Alaska statutes and all orders issued in the
domestic state are removed resulting in the insurer's return to good standing in its
state of domicile. Pursuant to AS 21.09.160 (b), this suspension shall
automatically suspend the authority of all of its agents to act as agents of
HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY in this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that during the period of the suspension, HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY shall not solicit or write any new business in the State of Alaska but shall file its Annual Statement, pay fees and any taxes due as provided by AS 21.09.170(b).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Certificate of Authority No. F-666 will continue to be held in safekeeping by HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY until such time as this order is replaced by an Order of Revocation or the Certificate of Authority is surrendered.
