WHEREAS, the Certificate of Authority of HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY to conduct the business of insurance in the State of Alaska was suspended effective April 18, 2002 and the suspension has continued to the present.

WHEREAS, Certificate of Authority No. F-666 issued to HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY to transact the busine is of insurance in the State of Alaska will expire on June 30, 2006 as there has been no payment of the continuation fee as required by AS 21.09.130. Pursuant to AS 21.09.160 (b), this expiration shall automatically revoke the authority of all of its agents to act as agents of HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY in this state. The company

shall give immediate notice of this action to its agents and managing general agents operating in the State of Aluska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Certificate of Authority No. F-666 held in safekeeping by HIGHLANDS INSURANCE COMPANY shall be returned to the Alaska Division of Insurance by July 31, 2006.
