shall not solicit or write new business in the State of Alaska but shall file the

annual statement, pay fees and any taxes due as provided by AS 21.09.170(b).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Certificate of Authority No. F-494 will continue to be held in safekeeping by PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY

INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA until such time as this order is replaced by an Order of Revocation, the Certificate of Authority is surrendered or the Certificate of Authority expires.
