ACCUSATION & FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of
Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states
the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

1. On February 24th, 2023, the Alaska Department of Commerce,
Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance
(Division) received a renewal application for an Insurance Producer
license to transact the business of Life & Health insurance for **JOHN
SYDNEY ALEXANDER (ALEXANDER)**, domiciled in the State of
Texas. The initial license was issued March 23rd, 2021. The license has
an expiration date of February 28 on odd numbered years.

- 1 2. Upon review of the renewal application, it was discovered
2 **ALEXANDER** responded negatively to background question to 1B at
3 initial licensure. **ALEXANDER** has indicated no criminal conviction to
4 report to the State of Alaska. The Producer Database reflects 1033
5 waiver of consent from State of Texas effective May 24th, 2019, due to
6 **ALEXANDER'S** criminal history. Neither the criminal history nor
7 1033 waiver was disclosed to the Division.

10 3. The Producer Database reflects administrative actions taken against
11 **ALEXANDER** by the State of Illinois, in effect on July 28th, 2021, and
12 by the State of Louisiana, in effect on March 3rd, 2022. At renewal,
13 **ALEXANDER** responded negatively to Background Question 2, failing
14 to report the administrative actions upon renewal. This information has
15 not been disclosed to the Division and was not supplied in support of the
16 renewal application in the attachment warehouse.

18 4. On February 27th, 2023, correspondence was provided to
19 **ALEXANDER** providing the opportunity for **ALEXANDER** to
20 voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and
21 accurate application within 15 days. No response was received.
22
23 5. On March 4th, 2023, and April 5th, 2023, expiration notices were
24 provided to **ALEXANDER** informing that the license had expired for
25 failure to renew.

27 6. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state,
28 the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with

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1 this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a
2 person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who
3 has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is
4 qualified under this chapter."

6 7. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an
7 individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy
8 person."

10 8. AS 21.27.025(a) states that "(a) A licensee shall notify the director in
11 writing not later than 30 days after a change in residence, place of
12 business, legal name, fictitious name, or alias, mailing address,
13 electronic mailing address, telephone number, or compliance officer. A
14 licensee shall report to the director in writing any administrative action
15 taken against the licensee by a governmental agency of another state, by
16 a governmental agency of another jurisdiction, or by a financial industry
17 regulatory authority sanction or arbitration proceeding not later than 30
18 days after the final disposition of the action. A licensee shall submit to
19 the director the final order and other relevant legal documents in the
20 action. A licensee shall report to the director any criminal prosecution of
21 the licensee in this or another state or jurisdiction not later than 30 days
22 after the date of filing of the criminal complaint, indictment,
23 information, or citation in the prosecution. The licensee shall submit to
24 the director a copy of the criminal complaint, calendaring order, and
25 other relevant legal documents in the prosecution."
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9. AS 21.27.025(b) states that “(b) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a failure to notify the director as required by this section is cause for denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.”

10. AS 21.27.040(a) states that “(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief...”

11. Pursuant to AS 21.27.025(a) and (b), **ALEXANDER** failed to report his criminal history at initial licensure, and failed to report the administrative actions which must be reported to the Division within 30 days. Based on the above **ALEXANDER’S** insurance producer renewal application is hereby **DENIED**.

FINAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.020 that **JOHN SYDNEY ALEXANDER’s** application for the Insurance Producer license in Alaska under National Producer Number (NPN) # 19180330 is **DENIED** for supplying inaccurate information on the

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1 initial and renewal application for licensure. **ALEXANDER** may apply for licensure in Alaska
2 after a period of 30 days has lapsed from the effective date of this order.
