ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

- On March 3rd, 2023, JAMIE LYNN WILSON (WILSON), domiciled in the State of Georgia applied for Insurance Producer license requesting Casualty and Property authority with the Division to conduct business in the State of Alaska.
- Upon review of the application, WILSON responded negatively to background question 2, indicating no administrative actions to report to the State of Alaska.

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- 3. The Producer Database and the Attachment Warehouse reflects administrative action was taken against WILSON in State of California in effect on January 17th, 2023. WILSON failed to disclose her administrative actions to the Division and provided misstatement on application.
- 4. On April 25th, 2023, correspondence was provided to WILSON informing of its failure to respond accurately to a background question of its administrative actions. The Division also provided WILSON the opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was received.
- 5. Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief…"
- AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with
