ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

- On November 22, 2023, VENITA HILLERY (HILLERY), domiciled in the State of Illinois applied for an Insurance Producer license requesting Personal Lines of authority with the Division to conduct business in the State of Alaska.
- Upon review of the application, HILLERY responded negatively to background question 2, indicating no administrative actions to report to the State of Alaska.

- 3. The Producer Database and the Attachment Warehouse reflects administrative action was taken against HILLERY in State of Pennsylvania in effect March 7, 2022, and in the State of California in effect May 23, 2022. HILLERY failed to disclose her administrative actions to the Division and provided inaccurate information on her application.
- 4. On December 1, 2023, correspondence was provided to HILLERY informing of her failure to respond accurately to a background question regarding administrative actions. The Division provided HILLERY the opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was received.
- 5. Alaska Statute 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief..."
