ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

- On February 28th, 2023, BENJAMIN CHRISTOPHER MCCRAY
 (MCCRAY), domiciled in the State of North Carolina applied for
 Insurance Producer license with Life authority with the Division to
 conduct insurance business in the State of Alaska.
- Upon review of the application, MCCRAY responded negatively to background questions 1A and 1B, indicating no criminal convictions to report to the State of Alaska. The Producer Database reflects the State of

North Carolina issued **MCCRAY** a 1033 waiver consenting to engage business of insurance in effect August 9th, 2018.

- 3. In addition, on March 3rd, 2023, MCCRAY uploaded an incomplete documentation of a felony and misdemeanor conviction to the Attachment Warehouse, which are in effect November 8th, 2000, in the State of North Carolina as part of his application. MCCRAY failed to provide complete information on his initial application and responded to the background questions incorrectly.
- 4. On March 6th, 2023, correspondence was provided to MCCRAY informing of his failure to respond accurately to background questions regarding criminal convictions and of a 1033 consent waiver was issued. The Division provided MCCRAY the opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and accurate application within 15 days. No response was received.
- 5. Alaska Statute 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with
