




Utilities – Number of Meters














Cook Inlet Natural Gas Usage by %















Cook Inlet Projected Natural Gas Production Vs. ENSTAR Requirements 2006 - 2022


Cook Inlet Projected Natural Gas Production Vs. Total Utility Gas Requirements 2006 - 2022

Gas Supply November 2005 Outlook









Natural Gas Cost vs. Residential Transportation Charges








Comparative Fuel Costs 2006 South Central Alaska


Residential Energy Cost (\$/Mm Btu)
