**Significant Issues:**

**Silver Alert** - Jeffery Allen, Age: 67 Last Know Location: Central Peninsula Hospital, 250 Hospital Place Soldotna AK

**Yentna River Flooding** - The Governor’s office contacted SEOC regarding a constituent's report of flooding on the Yentna River. SEOC reached out to the constituents and found that some individuals in the area have voluntarily evacuated due to rising water levels. The primary concern expressed was a request for flood mitigation funding to elevate secondary homes, lodges, and boat launches. SEOC relayed this information to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Emergency Management, which confirmed that the evacuations involved cabins, secondary homes, lodges, and businesses, rather than primary residences. The event is localized, with the cities of Houston, Wasilla, and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough being the primary sources for emergency response.

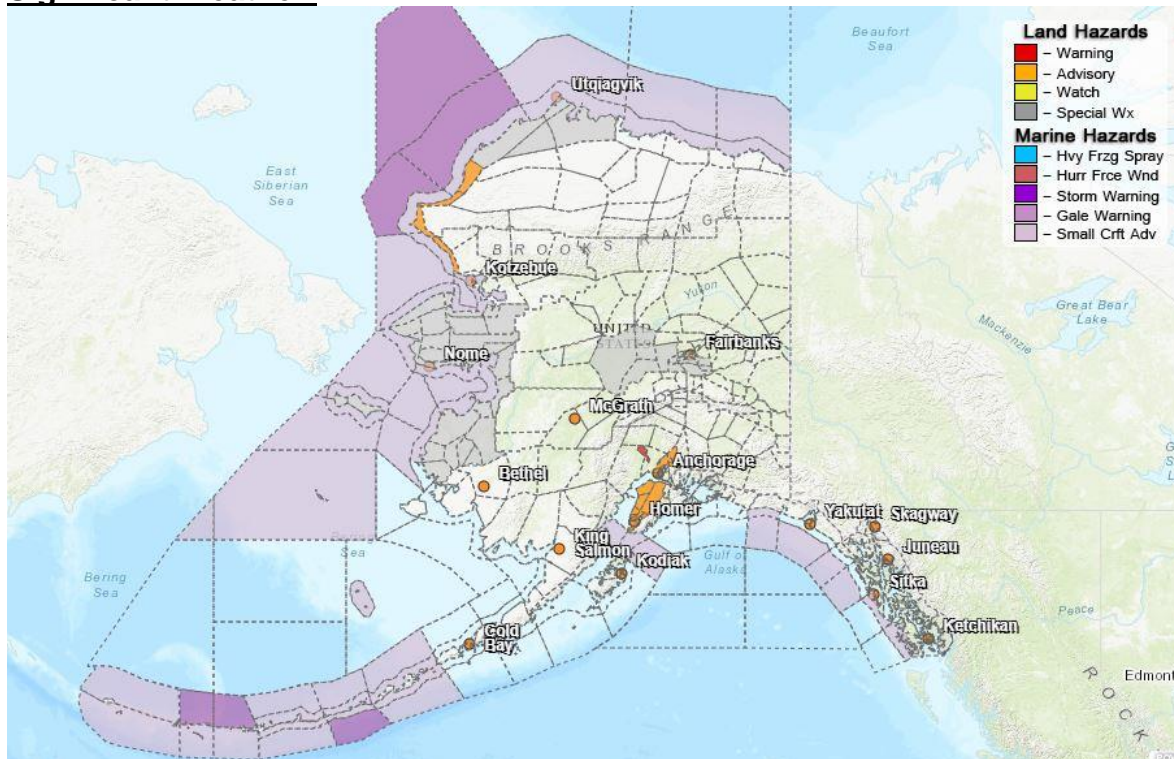

- Western Arctic Coast; Kivalina and Red Dog Dock – Tell 10pm this Wednesday.

### Special Weather Statement:

- Northern Seward Peninsula; Shishmaref; Bering Strait Coast; Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Interior Seward Peninsula; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Yukon Delta Coast; Lower Yukon River; St Lawrence Island – A coastal storm is expected to impact the West Coast of Alaska Thursday into Friday.
- Northwest Arctic Coast; Northern Arctic Coast – Elevated water levels and rough surf tell Wednesday morning.
