# **Overall Progress Narrative:**

On May 18, 2023, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) allocated \$38,493,000 in Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds to the State of Alaska for the purpose of assisting in long-term recovery from the 2022 Typhoon Merbok, a federally declared major disaster. HUD identified the "most impacted and distressed" areas: Bering Strait Regional Education Attendance Area, Kushunamiut Regional Education Attendance Area, and Lower Yukon Regional Education Attendance Area. The State of Alaska also identified the "most distressed and impacted" areas: Lower Kuskokwim Regional Education Attendance Area and the Pribilof Islands Regional Education Attendance Area. Beginning in May 2023, DCCED staff participated in the Interagency Recovery Coordination (IRC) Synchronization and Integration Meetings. On May 31, 2023, a new Grants Administration Manager was hired and on-boarded by DCCED. On June 1, 2023, HUD Region X staff visited the HUD-Anchorage Field Office and provided a presentation to DCCED on the use of CDBG-DR funds for Typhoon Merbok.
