Minutes of Meeting for January 21, 2025 at 1:30 p.m.
Via Zoom

Chair Larry Wood called the meeting to order at approximately 1:35 p.m. Commissioners John Harrington, Clayton Trotter, and Clay Walker were present. Commissioner Ely Cyrus was excused. Also present were LBC staff Jedediah Smith, Assistant Attorney General Gene Hickey, and approximately 35 members of the public.

Commissioner Harrington motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Walker seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0

Commissioner Harrington motioned to move into executive session for the purpose of receiving legal advice from Assistant Attorney General Hickey. Commissioner Walker seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

At approximately 2:10 p.m. the Commission returned from executive session. Chair Wood said the Commission took no action in executive session.

Commissioner Harrington motioned to accept the requests for reconsideration on the Xunaa Borough decision submitted by the City of Pelican, the City of Gustavus and the Community of Elfin Cove, the City of Tenakee Springs, and the Gustavus Visitors Association regarding the Xunaa Borough Petition and that reconsideration be limited to the two standards of Boundaries (3 AAC 110.060) and Best Interests of the State (3 AAC 110.065). Commissioner Walker seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Commissioner Harrington motioned to adjourn the meeting at approximately 2:20 p.m. Commissioner Walker seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
