CERTIFICATE

I, H. A. BOUCHER, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT, in accordance with the provisions of AS 29.10.022 an election for the incorporation of a fourth class city known as Napaskiak, Alaska, was held on October 12, 1971, within the boundaries of said proposed area for incorporation and that a majority of votes were cast for incorporation. The vote was 28 for and 23 against.

I DO FURTHER CERTIFY THAT the city of Napaskiak, Alaska is incorporated as a fourth class city;

THAT it possesses all the powers and privileges prescribed for cities of the fourth class by Title 29 of the ALASKA STATUTES:

THAT the boundaries of the said city are:

Beginning at the SW corner of Section 17, T7N, R71W, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence North to the point where the West boundary of Section 17, T7N, R71W, intersects the mean low water line of the Kuskokwim River; thence in a northeasterly direction along the mean low water line of the Kuskokwim River to the point where the East boundary of Section 4, T7N, R71W, intersects the mean low water line of the Kuskokwim River; thence South to the southeast corner of Section 16, T7N, R71W; thence West to the point of beginning, containing 3.25 square miles, more or less.

AND THAT on October 12, 1971, the following were elected as councilmen on the initial city council:

- Isaik H. Egoak
- Nicholas D. Steven
- Jack Wassillie

AND THAT the term of this office is to be one year unless determined otherwise by the city council.
