National Forest Receipts Program (NFR) Regional Education Attendance Areas Instructions FY2025 Application Requirements and Certification

National Forest Receipts Program regulations (3 AAC 132.050) require all entities that may be eligible for participation in the national forest receipts program (3 AAC 132.040) to submit an annual application including:

- An accounting report that documents the expenditure of income received from the NFR program for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 24 Schools payment,
- Unique Entity ID generated by SAM.gov, and
- Certification and Assurances.

Schools Payment:

3 AAC 132.070. Calculation of average daily membership

The amount of a payment made under the national forest receipts program to a regional educational attendance area or a municipal school district in the unorganized borough for public schools will be calculated based upon the average daily membership of school districts as determined under AS 14.17.600 and AS 41.15.180 (m), for the state fiscal year immediately preceding the application year.


