Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Massage Therapists against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Massage Therapists after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations amend 12 AAC 79 to update education requirements for license renewal, establish grounds for when the board may take disciplinary action against a licensee, and set standards for Internet advertisements.

Both the February 21, 2024 public notice and the June 10, 2024 order certifying the changes to regulations state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

No technical corrections were necessary to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060.

The attached three pages of regulations, dealing with clarification to license renewal continuing education requirements, grounds for disciplinary sanctions against licensees, and Internet advertising requirements, are certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Board of Massage Therapists adopted at its June 10, 2024 meeting, under the authority of AS 08.61.020, AS 08.61.030, AS 08.61.040, AS 08.61.050, AS 08.61.060, and AS 08.61.070, and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

On the record, in considering public comments, the Board of Massage Therapists paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes described in this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.

 - (1) failure by the licensee to
 - (A) cooperate with an official investigation by the board or an agent of the board;
 - (B) report to the board a disciplinary action taken against the licensee by another licensing jurisdiction, health care entity, or law enforcement agency within 30 days after the date of the action;
 - (2) disciplinary action taken against the licensee by another licensing authority;
 - (3) conviction of a crime that affects the licensee's ability to practice competently

12 AAC 79.950. Internet advertising requirements. (a) A licensed massage therapist or registered massage therapy establishment shall display the licensee's license number or massage therapy establishment's registration number on each Internet advertisement.

(b) For purposes of this section, "Internet advertisement" means a message in an Internet medium that offers or solicits a person to utilize the services of the advertising massage therapist or massage therapy establishment. (Eff. 7 / 26 / 2024, Register 251)
