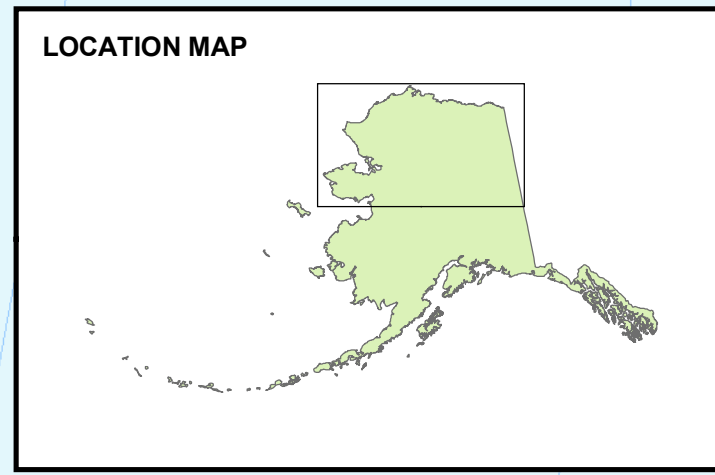

Notes:

This map shows general land ownership information. When covering the map, please refer to the Alaska ANCSA and State Land Information System (SLIS) for more detailed information. For example, any portion of a section (640 acres) that is not shown as being owned by the State of Alaska or the Bureau of Land Management is assumed to be owned by the private sector. Approved land under the ANCSA is shown as being owned by the State of Alaska. The State of Alaska also owns the land shown as being owned by the State of Alaska.

The Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) of 1971 provided for the settlement of Alaska Native land claims. The Act provided for the transfer of approximately 43 million acres of land to the State of Alaska and to 12 regional corporations. The State of Alaska also received approximately 170 million acres of land from the federal government. The ANCSA also provided for the settlement of Alaska Native claims to the land shown as being owned by the State of Alaska.
