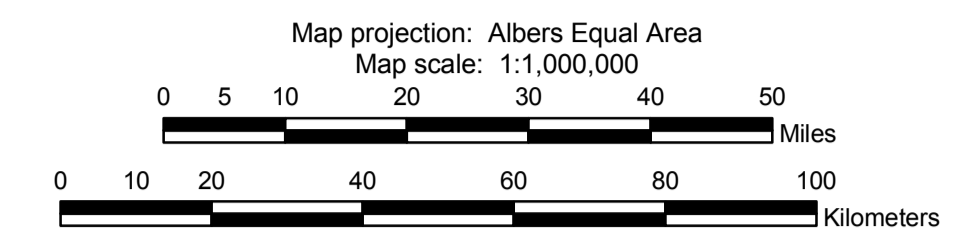

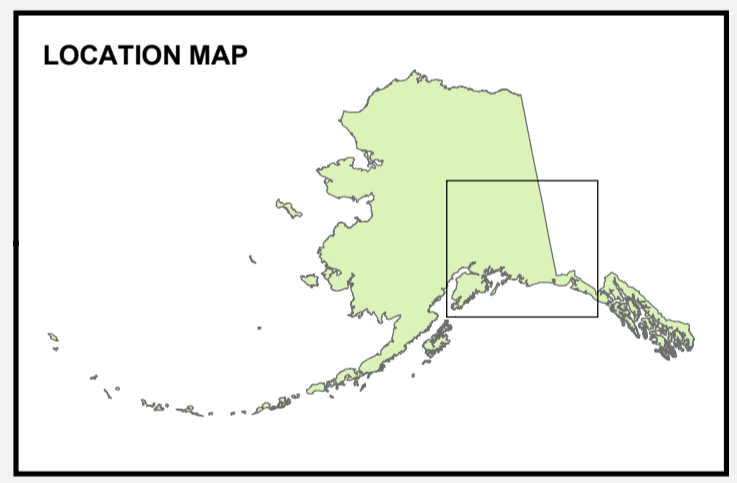

State Land Ownership: Alaska Department of Natural Resources (ADNR), Land Administration System (section-level resolution, April 2008).
State Legislatively Designated Areas: ADNR, Land Administration System (section-level resolution, February 2009).
ANCSA: Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, Bureau of Land Management (section-level resolution, April 2008).
Other Municipal and Private Lands: Patented/Disposed Federal Lands (Private Parcels), Bureau of Land Management (section-level resolution, April 2008) and ADNR, Land Administration System (section-level resolution, April 2008).
Native Allotments: Patented/Conveyed: Spatial data, Bureau of Land Management (ADNR, Spatial Data Management System, http://data.adnr.state.ak.us, March 30, 2005). Tabular data, Bureau of Land Management (ALIS, Alaska Land Information System, March 2005).
Conservation System Units: Bureau of Land Management (1991) and ADNR data (February 1998).
Military Lands: Bureau of Land Management (section-level resolution, April 2008).
Geographic Place Names: Dictionary of Alaska Place Names (1987) and U.S. Geological Survey Quadrangle Maps, (1:1 million scale, annotated by U.S. Geological Survey, 1994, and annotated by ADNR, June 1998).
Borough Boundaries: ADNR (approximately 1:1 million scale, annotated from U.S. Census Bureau, April 1990, revised and updated by ADNR and ADNR, December 1995).
Guide Use Area Boundaries and Identification Numbers: Alaska Department of Fish and Game, December 2008. Boundaries may be subject to adjustment with changes occurring to the Unified Code List boundaries.
The Alaska Marine National Wildlife Refuge (AMNWR) is not completely outlined. Areas where it is depicted are shaded, however, they are not outlined. The Alaska Marine NWR is depicted as follows:
The Alaska Marine NWR consists of all public lands, including submerged lands and waters thereof, in Alaska, North, South, and Central, and designated as such in the Unified Code List and other maps of Alaska with the following exceptions: (1) the Gulf of Alaska, Alaska Peninsula, and Gulf of Alaska OCS, and (2) includes an undetermined quantity of submerged lands. If any interest of federal ownership of the Gulf of Alaska OCS and Alaska Peninsula is shown on the USGS maps entitled, "Alaska Marine National Wildlife Refuge" dated October 1979.

Note: This map shows general land ownership information. When reviewing this map, please remember that federal, ANCSA, and state land ownership is depicted hierarchically, by section. For example, any portion of a section (640 acres) being either State Patented or Tentatively Approved land means the whole section is to be depicted as state land, even if the State Patented or Tentatively Approved land is only a fraction of the section, and federal land under ANCSA land also occurs in the section.

The land ownership hierarchy is as follows:

- State Municipal Entitlements or Land Exchanges or Other Land Disposals
- Patented/Disposed Federal Lands (Native Allotments or Private Parcels)
- State Patented or Tentatively Approved or Other State Acquired Lands (includes ANCSA lands, 11A, 11B, 11C, 11D, 11E, 11F, 11G, 11H, 11I, 11J, 11K, 11L, 11M, 11N, 11O, 11P, 11Q, 11R, 11S, 11T, 11U, 11V, 11W, 11X, 11Y, 11Z)
- Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) Patented or Interim Conveyed
- Major Military
- National Wildlife Refuges, National Park System Units
- National Wild and Scenic Rivers outside National Park System Units and National Wildlife Refuges
- National Forests and Monuments, National Petroleum Reserve-Alaska, National Recreation Areas and National Conservation Areas
- Bureau of Land Management Public Lands



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
