Underwood, Dawn	2021-000311	128176	<p>On November 7, 2024, the Alaska Board of Nursing adopted the Order of Default to revoke Dawn Underwood's advanced practice registered nurse license No. 128176, after a default proceeding in accordance with AS 44.62.530. The Division filed an Accusation against Ms. Underwood's advanced practice registered nurse license alleging violation of AS 08.68.340(a)(6). The central issue of the Accusation was Ms. Underwood did not reply to an Accusation and Notice of Defense regarding her working without a license, a violation of AS 08.68.340(a)(6). The Accusation was properly served in accordance with AS 44.62.380. Ms. Underwood failed to respond within 15 days of service as required by AS 44.62.390, and the Division proceeded to present its case of default to the Board on November 7, 2024. On November 13, 2024, the Order of Default was mailed by certified mail to Ms. Underwood's address of record in accordance with AS 44.62.530, which mail was returned to the Division, and the revocation became effective on December 13, 2024; 30 days after the decision was mailed or otherwise delivered (AS 44.62.520). Under AS 44.62.550 and 12 AAC 44.785, Ms. Underwood may apply to reinstate her license after one year from the effective date of its revocation.</p>	Default Revocation
