The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations establish standards for the board's executive director to hire special investigators.

Duties of director [CONDUCT OF OFFICE].

3 AAC 305.025(b) is amended to read:

(b) The director <u>shall</u> [WILL] employ and supervise necessary administrative, professional, paraprofessional, and investigative personnel and <u>shall</u> [WILL] prescribe <u>their</u> [THAT PERSON'S] duties and authority. <u>The director may employ a person to a position</u> with the special investigator job classification only if the person

(1) possesses a certificate issued by the Alaska Police Standards Council demonstrating that the person meets the standards for appointment as a police officer under AS 18.65.240;

(2) provides evidence satisfactory to the director that

(A) the person meets the standards of another state or a federal jurisdiction for appointment as a police officer; and

(B) the standards of the state or federal jurisdiction are equivalent to
the standards required for issuance of a certificate by the Alaska Police Standards
Council under AS 18.65.240; or

(3) is eligible for appointment as a police officer through reciprocity in accordance with 13 AAC 85.060.
