Requested Action: Consider a transfer of location of a license under AS 04.11.400(k).

Statutory and Regulatory Authority: 3 AAC 305.130. Consideration of transfer of location of a license under AS 04.11.400(k). (a) An application to transfer a license under AS 04.11.400(k) in a borough with a population of 50,000 or more into or within an incorporated city in the borough must comply with the notice requirements set out in AS 04.11.280, 04.11.290, and 3 AAC 305.070(d), as applicable.

Sec. 04.11.400. Population limitations. (a) Except as provided in (f), (i), and (k) [(d), (f), and (h) - (k)] of this section and AS 04.11.405, a new license may not be issued, and the board may prohibit relocation of an existing license

(k) The board may allow the relocation of an existing beverage dispensary license under AS 04.09.200 or former AS 04.11.090 to a restaurant, eating place, or hotel, motel, resort, or similar business that contains a restaurant or eating place, an existing package store license under AS 04.09.230 or former AS 04.11.150, existing brewery retail license under AS 04.09.320, an existing winery retail license under AS 04.09.330, or an existing distillery retail license under AS 04.09.340 in a borough with a population of 50,000 or more into or within an incorporated city in the borough. The board may not approve the relocation unless, at the time of application, the existing number of issued licenses of the type under consideration for relocation located within the borough exceeds the maximum allowed under (a) of this section, and the governing bodies of both the borough and the incorporated city approve the relocation. The board may allow not more than three relocations into each city under this subsection each decade. In this subsection, "decade" means each 10-year period beginning April 1 in a year ending in zero.

3 AAC 305.070. Application for transfer of location. (a) An applicant to transfer an alcoholic beverage license or an alcoholic beverage license with one or more endorsements to a new location must file an application on a form prescribed by the board. The application must include the information and documentation described in this section. The application may be initiated and completed electronically.

(2) a statement identifying whether the transfer to a new location is subject to AS 04.11.400(k) and identifying the involved borough and incorporated city; and

(d) If a transfer of an alcoholic beverage license or an alcoholic beverage license with one or more endorsements to another location is subject to AS 04.11.400(k), before the application is submitted to the board:

(1) not more than 10 business days after the board office determines that the application is complete and the prerequisites of AS 04.11.400(k) are satisfied, the office of the board will notify the affected borough and incorporated city of the transfer of location application, and, if applicable, an accompanying transfer of license to another person; the notice will include

(A) the date the board office received the complete application;

(B) the license number;

(C) the present or previous business name of the license to be transferred;

(D) the names of the transferee and the transferor, if the application includes a request to transfer a license or a license with one or more endorsements to another person; and

(E) the proposed new location of the license;

(2) the borough and incorporated city affected by the transfer request under AS 04.11.400(k) may respond to the notice under (a) of this section not later than 60 days after receipt of the notice; the borough and incorporated city may request an extension of time to respond. The board may grant a request for an extension of up to 120 additional days;

(3) within the notification period, the borough and the municipality must provide written notification that they agree to the transfer under AS 04.11.400(k) to be approved by the office of the board; the board will not approve a transfer of location if the notification required by this paragraph is not received within the time allowed under (d)(2) of this section; if the borough and municipality timely respond, the board may consider whether to approve the relocation under 3 AAC 305.130.

Staff Rec.: Consider a transfer of location of a license under AS 04.11.400(k).

Background: Staff has reviewed and determined that the transfer application that is being considered under AS 04.11.400(k) is complete and compliant with 3 AAC 305.130.





SECURITY PLAN STATEMENT

Addie Camp

Addie Camp Dining Car will have 2 outdoor seating areas:

The FIRST FLOOR deck will only be accessible from the inside lobby through a door between the train car and the kitchen. A hostess or manager will seat customers on the deck only after they check-in at the main entrance to the building.

The first floor deck has a second emergency exit behind the kitchen in order to meet fire code. This exit will have a lockable gate, and will NOT be a public entrance/exit. The deck is elevated above ground level, and enclosed with a railing system constructed with "pig fence" which also meets building code.

The SECOND FLOOR deck is a wrap-around six foot wide walkway with 2 doors, and an exterior staircase to the lower deck. A hostess or manager will also seat customers upstairs only after they check-in at the main entrance to the building. The exterior stairs meet fire code for emergency exit off the second floor, and will also be secured with a lockable gate. The exterior stairs will NOT be a public entrance/exit to the second floor. Access to the second floor dining area and outside walkway will be up the staircase located just inside the main entrance, or by using the elevator on the main floor.



This form must be completed and submitted along with all other required forms and documents before any endorsement application will be considered complete and placed in the queue for our licensing examiners review.

Section 2 – Endorsement Requested

An application for a restaurant endorsement must specify the establishment or portion of the establishment that constitutes a bona fide restaurant, that there is supervision on the premises adequate to reasonably ensure that a person under 21 years of age will not obtain alcoholic beverages. This **endorsement** application is for the request of a designation as a bona fide restaurant, hotel, or eating place for purposes of AS 04.16.010(c) or AS 04.16.049, and for the request of the following designation(s) (check all that apply):

1. **Dining after standard closing hours:** AS 04.16.010(c)
2. **Dining by persons 16 – 20 years of age:** AS 04.16.049(a)
3. **Dining by persons under the age of 16 years,** accompanied by a person over the age of 21: AS 04.16.049(a)
4. **Employment for any persons under 21 years of age:** AS 04.16.049(c)

NOTE: Under AS 04.16.049(d), a Department of Labor and Workforce Development work permit is not required to employ a person 18 - 20 years of age.


