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Manley Hot Springs Resort Outdoor/Indoor Serving Security Plan

- 1. All minors must be accompanied by an adult (age over 21) while in the restricted area when any alcohol is being served/sold/consumed.
- 2. All new patrons are carded upon ordering alcohol.
- 3. All staff is trained in the identification of fake IDs.
- 4. Deck railing at a height of 42" is around the outdoor servicing area.
- 5. Underaged persons will be monitored closely by our professionally trained alcohol servers.
- 6. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
- 7. ABC mandated posters as required by law are posted inside Manley Hot Springs Resort and at the entrances of the outdoor seating area.
- 8. All entrances and exits will provide clear notice that NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED BEYOND THE OUTDOOR SEATING AREA.
- 9. Keeping outdoor seating area viable without any increased risk to minors exposed to alcohol WILL continue to be a part of our training for our staff.
- 10. All safety related operations for our current liquor service will additionally be enforced in the new service area.
- 11. Proper signage at points of entry indicating no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.

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- 12. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been carded will have alcoholic beverages.
- 13. Our top priority continues in providing safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages.
- 14. Servers will be present in the outdoor area to monitor consumption.

Minors will be under the direct supervision at all times and have restricted access to the areas where alcohol is located. Employed minors will not be allowed to work unless an employee over the age of 21 with a TAPS card is also working. The bar will be attended at all times by an employee with a valid TAPS card and all alcohol storage not behind the bar will be in locked storage within the building. Minors will not have access to the liquor storage. Access to all alcohol is restricted to TAPS personal only. A minor will request the assistance of an employee with a TAPS card to take any alcohol orders. Minors will not clear any tables for guests that leave unconsumed alcoholic beverages on the tables.

Underage employees will be instructed not to discuss alcohol sales with any customer and are to get a waitress/employee who has a TAPS card to address customer inquiries regarding the same.

100% ID check will be in force to ensure no minors are served.
