Staff is required to thoroughly check the ID of every individual they suspect of being underage. At the conclusion of the training, they are provided with their TAPS card.

All alcoholic beverages are dispensed and monitored by employees over the age of 21.

As soon as the last meal service is completed and our guests depart, all beer and wine are secured in locked facilities and beer taps are secured with locks.

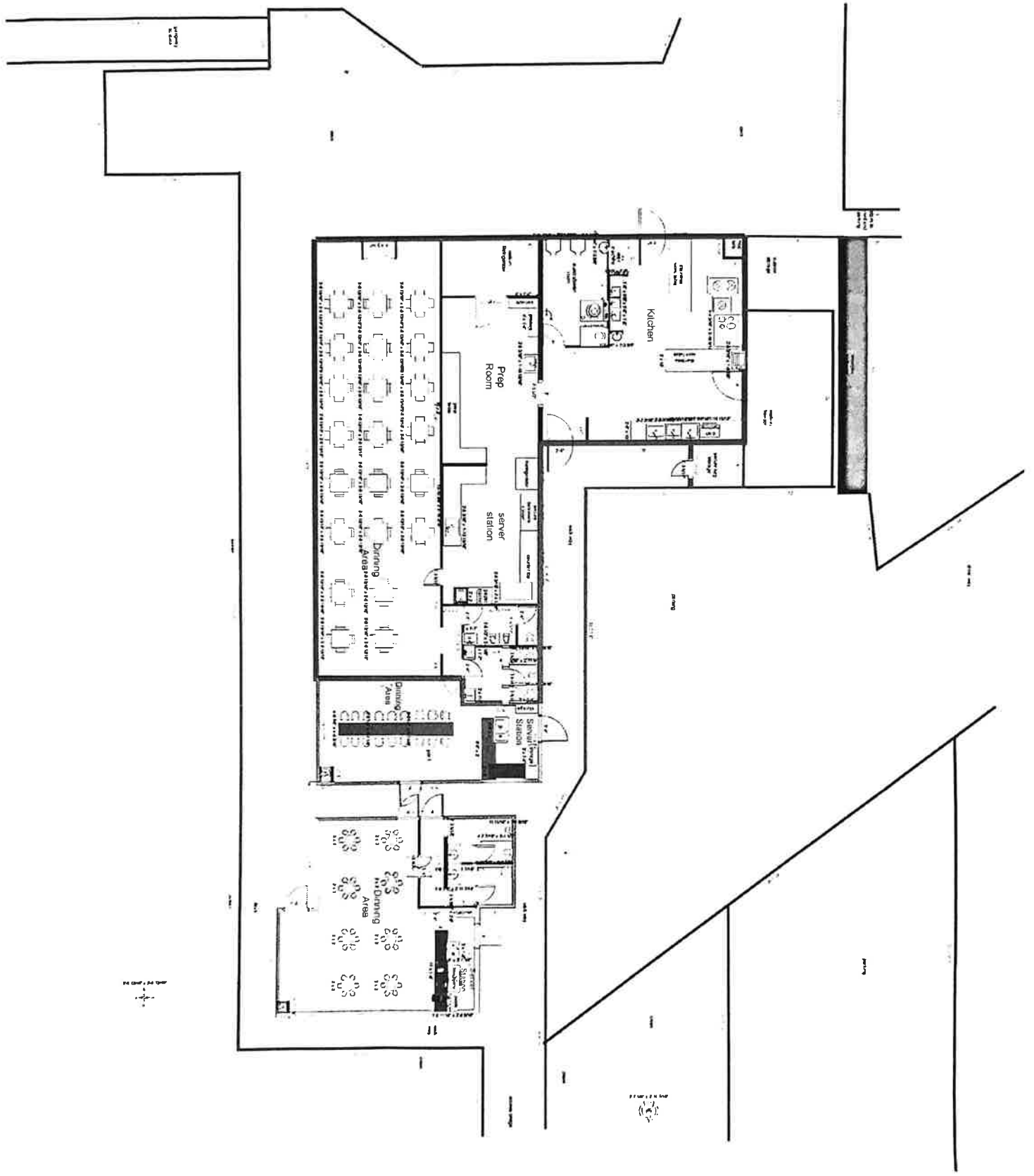

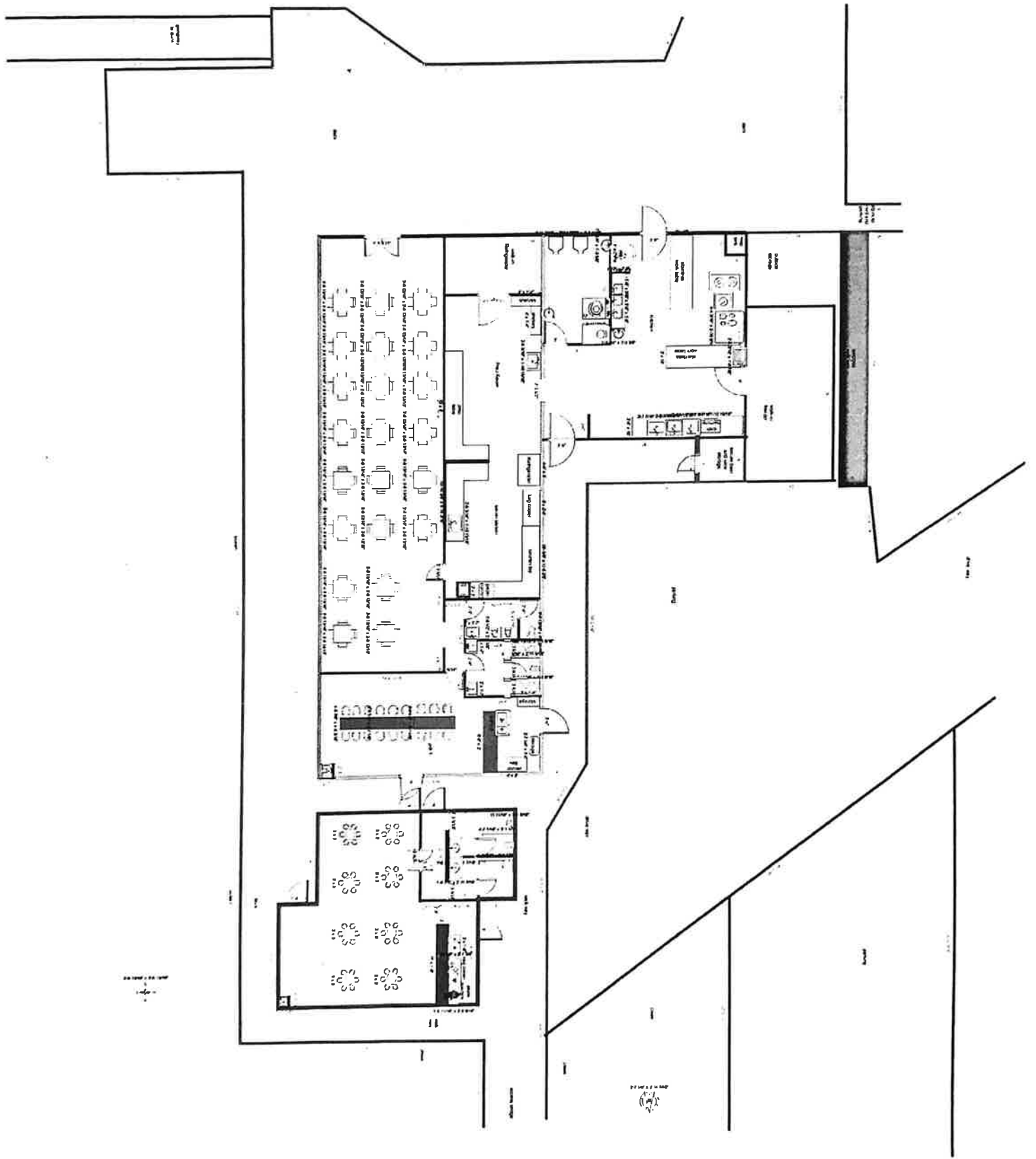
