Outdoor/Indoor Serving Security Plan

1. All minors must be accompanied by an adult (age over 21) while in the restricted area when any alcohol is being served/sold/consumed.
2. All new patrons are carded upon ordering alcohol.
3. All staff is trained in the identification of fake IDs.
4. A 36" railing and a 60" privacy fence is around the outdoor servicing area.
5. Underaged persons will be monitored closely by our professionally trained alcohol servers.
6. Proper egress from the outdoor service area will always remain unobstructed.
7. ABC mandated posters as required by law are posted inside The Fisherman's Daughter and at the entrances of the outdoor seating area.
8. All entrances and exits will provide clear notice that NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED BEYOND THE OUTDOOR SEATING AREA.
9. Keeping outdoor seating area viable without any increased risk to minors exposed to alcohol WILL continue to be a part of our training for our staff.
10. All safety related operations for our current liquor service will additionally be enforced in the new service area.
11. Proper signage at points of entry indicating no minors without a parent or legal guardian will be posted.
12. All servers will closely monitor that only the guests that have been carded will have alcoholic beverages.
13. Our top priority continues in providing safety for all guests regarding the service of alcoholic beverages.
14. Servers will be present in the outdoor area to monitor consumption.

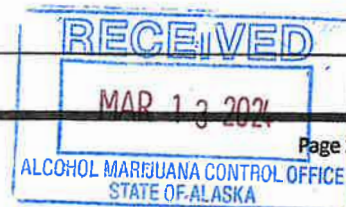

Section 3 – Minor Access

Minor patrons will have access to the outdoor and indoor dining areas as well as the restroom area. Customers will not have access to storage areas or “employee only” areas.

Minor employees will have access to all employee areas and customer areas with the exception of the alcohol storage area. This is a locked area with access only available to certified and trained alcohol servers.

Policies/ Practices

Customers order food and non-alcoholic beverages at designated order counter. Table numbers are given to the customer and the food and non-alcoholic beverages are delivered to the table by servers.

Customers order Alcoholic beverages from a separate counter designated for alcohol sales only. The alcoholic beverages are served to the customer at the point of sale. Staff operating this point-of-sale counter will have proper training and certification (current Server Education Card) as well as managerial oversight.

There will be two managers on site at all times with training and certification for alcohol sales. All staff will have training monitoring the two exits (both visible from the beer and wine server station as well as the food order counter) to ensure alcohol is to stay in designated areas. Appropriate signage will also be in place.

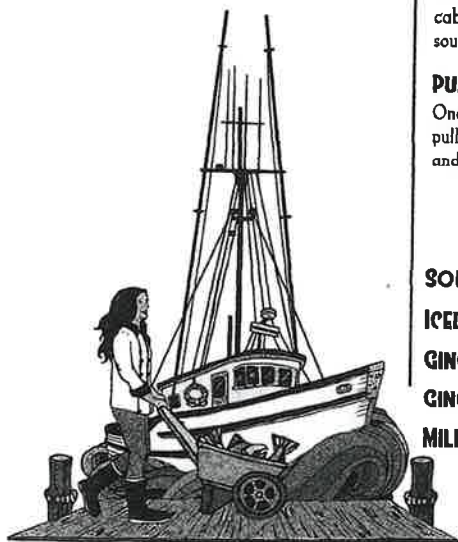
