This project was opened at the June 2024 Board meeting. The attached regulations draft is for board discussion. It proposes to amend:

3 AAC 306.435(a)(3). Marijuana inventory tracking system.

This is amended to remove any limit on how large a batch of clones or cuttings must be for tracking purposes
